great honour for the team, and road racing in general, for the bike to be selected this year as they normally have MotoGP and World Superbike machines on their stand. The bike has been one of the most successful machines in road racing history - it currently holds the Dundrod 150 lap record, outright Southern 100 course record, TT Superbike lap record, more 131mph TT laps than any other bike and is the fastest bike from a standing start in TT history. Perhaps it would hold more records if Conrod had made it to Dundrod in August!
