# Big night with road racing legends

Road racing legends from the Isle of Man TT races will be in Shropshire in February to take part in a charity fundraising night.

Organisers hope to raise around £10,000 from the evening, which will be held at the Wynnstay Hotel in Oswestry on February 15.

Billed as an evening with John McGuinness – king of the Isle of Man – the evening will also feature TT winners Michael Rutter and Tommy Robb, six times British cham-

pion James Whitham and four times Gold Cup winner Guy Martin.

The night will begin with an auction of TT memorabilia from 4pm to 6pm followed by the speakers from 7.30pm onwards.

One of the organisers, Phil Morris, said that as well as the speakers, guests in the audience would include David Cretney the Isle of Man minister of tourism, Paul Phillips the TT co-ordinator, and from the world of road racing, Frank Perris, Nick Jeffries and

Tom Dickie. The theme of this year's event will be 100 years of TT.

"We aim to raise £10,000 for charity," Mr Morris said.

Local businesses are being urged to sponsor the guest speakers and Mr Morris is also appealing for TT memorabilia.
