Also attending the event, Patron and Six Times British Champion; Jamie Whittham. Jamie has been and will remain one of the organizations biggest supporters. Whilst his position of Patron will always stand firm, he will also be the events Compere.



Yet to confirm his attendance whilst looking forward to his 2010 British Superbike Championship on the Motorpoint/Henderson Yamaha, Neil Hodgson. After a 1st place podium finish at the 2000 and 2003 World Superbike Championship, Neil could be returning from his American Superbike Championship to guest star at the February event in an effort to increase the level of support to the organisation and the funds raised for the yet to be decided beneficiary's.



Also yet to confirm his attendance is 1992, 2001 and 2004, retired British Superbike champion John Reynolds. After his serious accident in 2005 at Brands Hatch, his retirement has by no means taken him out of the spotlight.
