SEVENTH ANNUAL ROAD RACING LEGENDS

The seventh annual Road Racing Legends, held on February 17, at the Wynnstay Hotel, Oswestry, North Shropshire played host to TT aces Ryan Farquhar, the TT's fastest lady Jenny Tinmouth, Ian Hutchinson, and John McGuinness, with the compere for the evening being RRL patron James Witham.

Unfortunately Guy Martin failed to make the evening, despite agreeing terms 12 months earlier. John McGuinness had flown in from Sepang, Malaysia, where he had been testing with the Honda TT Legends World Endurance team, and Ian Hutchinson signed himself out of hospital for the evening, before returning to continue treatment on his broken leg the next day. The evening raised a staggering £22,088 which takes the total raised overall by Road Race Legends to £105,340 since 2005.
