

### Star's scooter sells for £800

A SCOOTER used by TT rider John McGuinness in the pits during events in the Isle of Man sold for £800 at auction at a charity night in Oswestry.

The machine was donated to the Road Racing Legends Charity by the parents of the former owner, dentist Aled Jenkins, who died in a road accident in April.

The cash helped the organisers raise £22,088 on the night and the Legends have now raised a total of £105,340 over a seven year period.

The scooter was bought from John McGuinness in the pit lane at last year's TT races by Oswestry race enthusiast, Phil Morris, who each year organises a charity memorabilia auction with Colin Morris from Craven Arms.

He subsequently sold it to Mr Jenkins but - following Mr Jenkins' death - it was donated to the charity.
